Dear Ilaria,

In response to your letter dated 5th October 2020, we the people write to clarify the following points that you raised:

- The Particulars of Claim that you refer to **are the previously attached documents**, the Lawful Notice, Affidavit, Royal Proclamations and Exhibits.
- In relation to a court fee, **we the people are not required to pay such a fee** as the rules of civil procedure do not apply to us, if you can confirm the law that states otherwise we are happy to comply.


As the people have already paid to establish your company, your request for a further payment would be theft and a crime against the people.

To insist on a payment would confirm that you are also guilty of committing various crimes against the people, including criminal coercion, forced slavery and fraud.

- To assist you in this matter we have enclosed the three copies that you require.

It should also be noted that as this issue has been raised by the people (represented by John Smith) and is of public concern, all documentation relating to this will also be posted on the website www.commonlawcourt.com

To confirm the position of the people we refer you to the 100 sample signatures provided on the Declaration of the Common law Court (Exhibit 3). Should you require further proof of our standing we are happy to have 100 people attend your place of business, provided you confirm that they will be accommodated?
