CONFIRMING THE VERDICT OF THE COURT

It is hereby ordered that after a unanimous decision of the jury, the previous decision issued against the Plaintiff regarding his property on the 4th April 2018 (LIV-B560-17 Livingstone Sheriff Court), has now been annulled.

It is further ordered that each of the Defendants are liable in their personal and private capacity for a financial penalty of £7,500, the sum for this penalty has been determined by the jury and will be payable to the Plaintiff within a period of fourteen (14) days from the signed receipt of this order.

It is further ordered that the Defendants are liable for a financial penalty of £7,500, this sum is an award to cover expenses and has been determined by the jury. The sum awarded will be split between the Defendants (£3,750 each) and will be payable to the Plaintiff within a period of fourteen (14) days from the signed receipt of this order.

In the event that these orders are not complied with, the Common Law Court will take further action against the individuals concerned, to enforce its decisions.

These Court Orders are effective as of this date and will remain in force until such time as they have been enforced. These orders are issued under the authority of this Common Law Court and jus gentium, the Law of Nations.
