CONFIRMING THE VERDICT OF THE COURT

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In relation to the Statement of Claim presented this day by Rekha Patel on behalf of the Plaintiffs, the supporting evidence and the failure of the Defendants to appear, we the jury find the Defendants guilty on the following counts:

1. Conspiracy to defraud.
2. Fraud.
3. Perjury committed during statutory court proceedings.
4. Deception and the unlawful use of statutory courts.
5. Theft of property.
6. Harm, loss and injury caused to the defendant.

It is hereby ordered that after a unanimous decision of the jury, that all previous statutory orders issued against the Plaintiff, relating to her and the property mentioned, have now been annulled.

It is further ordered that each of the Defendants are liable in their personal and private capacity for compensation, this compensation to cover actual financial loss. The following sums have been determined by the jury:

Cost of house	£250,000
Property renovations	£ 77,500
Lost belongings	£ 45,500
Lost salary & legal costs (8 years)	£110,000

It is further ordered that the Defendants are to compensate the Plaintiff for additional loss, this sum to cover a two-year period which would be required to restore her to her former position.



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Loss of salary	£200,000
Lost pension	£ 18,000
Rental costs for accommodation	£ 22,000

It is further ordered that each of the Defendants are liable in their personal and private capacity for damages, this sum to be by way of compensation for the actions caused by the Defendants and to be determined by the jury.

Homelessness for 500 days	£ 50,000
Stress	£480,000
Time suffered	£100,000
Lost career	£400,000
Lost pension	£250,000
Lost future earnings	£500,000
Additional award for loss of house & equity	£450,000

The sum awarded (£2,953,000) for the above orders will be split between the Defendants (see below) and will be payable to the Plaintiff within a period of fourteen (14) days from the signed receipt of this order.

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If these orders are not complied with, the Common Law Court will take further action against the individuals concerned, to enforce its decisions.

These Court Orders are effective as of this date and will remain in force until such time as they have been enforced. These orders are issued under the authority of this Common Law Court and jus gentium, the Law of Nations.
