Crawford J. Langley, Town House, Broad Street, Aberdeen AB10 1FY (Respondent)

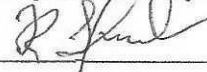

We the Jury confirm that the Respondent owes the Pursuer the sum of £1,607,365 and therefore issue a COMMON LAW DECREE to enable enforcement.

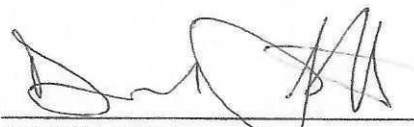
We swear and acknowledge that this verdict and decree was decided by we the Jury unanimously and without coercion or influence.
