

## **COURT ORDER**

CONFIRMING THE VERDICT OF THE COURT

(Common Law Use of Marijuana)

In relation to the Statement of Claim presented this day, by David Paterson (applicant), the Court issues the following order.

It is hereby ordered that after a unanimous decision of the court, it is now lawful for any man or women over the age of eighteen to use the marijuana plant for its medicinal properties, under Common Law.
