

COURT ORDER

CONFIRMING THE VERDICT OF THE COURT

In relation to the Statement of Claim presented this day by Joanna Cridlin (Plaintiff), the supporting evidence and the failure of the Defendant to appear, we the jury find the Defendant guilty on the following counts:

- 1. The unlawful enforcement of statutory rules to target the Plaintiff.
- 2. The unlawful use of the statutory courts to target the Plaintiff.
- 3. Lodging a fraudulent claim against the Plaintiff, causing harm, loss and injury.
- 4. The unlawful damage and theft of Plaintiffs personal property.
- 5. The failure by the Defendant to lodge a written or verbal defence.
- 6. The failure of the Defendant to accept the authority of the people, the Common Law Court and the issued summons.

It is hereby ordered that after a unanimous decision of the court, the previous decision and fine issued against the Plaintiff (Case. No. 011701415040) by the statutory court, has now been annulled.
